Math Inventory Assessment

In the Fall of 2015-16 only a portion of grade 5 students took the Math Inventory, in the following years all grade 5 students took the Math Inventory. In the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years middle school students enrolled in high school credit courses did not take the Spring Math Inventory.

Growth was assessed on the average annual growth identified in the 2015 HMH Math Inventory Research Study. Estimated growth is based on Fall Assessment scores, and higher scores do not have an estimated growth. As result, growth findings in the following data do not include those who scored advanced in the Fall.
