

APPENDIX C11 - Secondary Student Survey Results

Secondary student surveys were administered in January 2023 to grades 6 through 12 and included closed and open-ended questions. Prior to administration, surveys were pre-tested with a select group of students at the secondary level and feedback from student pre-testing was considered and edits were made to the survey. Questions for students focused on visits to the library, perceptions of the library, and ability to navigate library resources.
