Meeting Opening and Introductions

Committee Chair, Dr. Barbara Kanninen, provided a brief recap of topics covered in the first meting and the format of this meeting. The committee members present divided into three small groups – students, staff and community – to discuss the names they generated and feedback from their peers and community members since the first meeting. Then, all groups presented their ideas.

Chair Kanninen reminded everyone that the goal for the meeting is not to debate the current ACC name—rather, to review the possible new names and arrive at short list to send out to the community for input via a survey. She also confirmed that ACC would be an option on the survey.

Parent participants asked what occurs if we field the survey of our top names, and then new names emerge. The chair confirmed that we will consider all names suggested in this next phase.
